PLACES OF INTEREST

- A Golden Water Mouth Tree**
Made from a dead yellow box gumtree. Water trickles down its gold leaf plated branches. The water symbolises life and the gold fosters prosperity.
- B Kwong Wah Chong at 84 Dixon Street**
The oldest remaining shopfront - established in 1912 at the hype of the famous noodle cafes, gambling houses and refuges for seamen from China.
- C Chinese Gardens**
A project of the State of NSW and Guadon Province in China to commemorate Australia's 1988 Bicentenary.
- D Ceremonial Arch and Stone Dragons**
Symbol of protection: male dragon with one paw on top of a globe to symbolise caring for the world. Female dragon with one paw over her cub for the protection of children and family.
- E War Memorial**
Commemorating the contribution of people of Chinese background throughout the history of war.

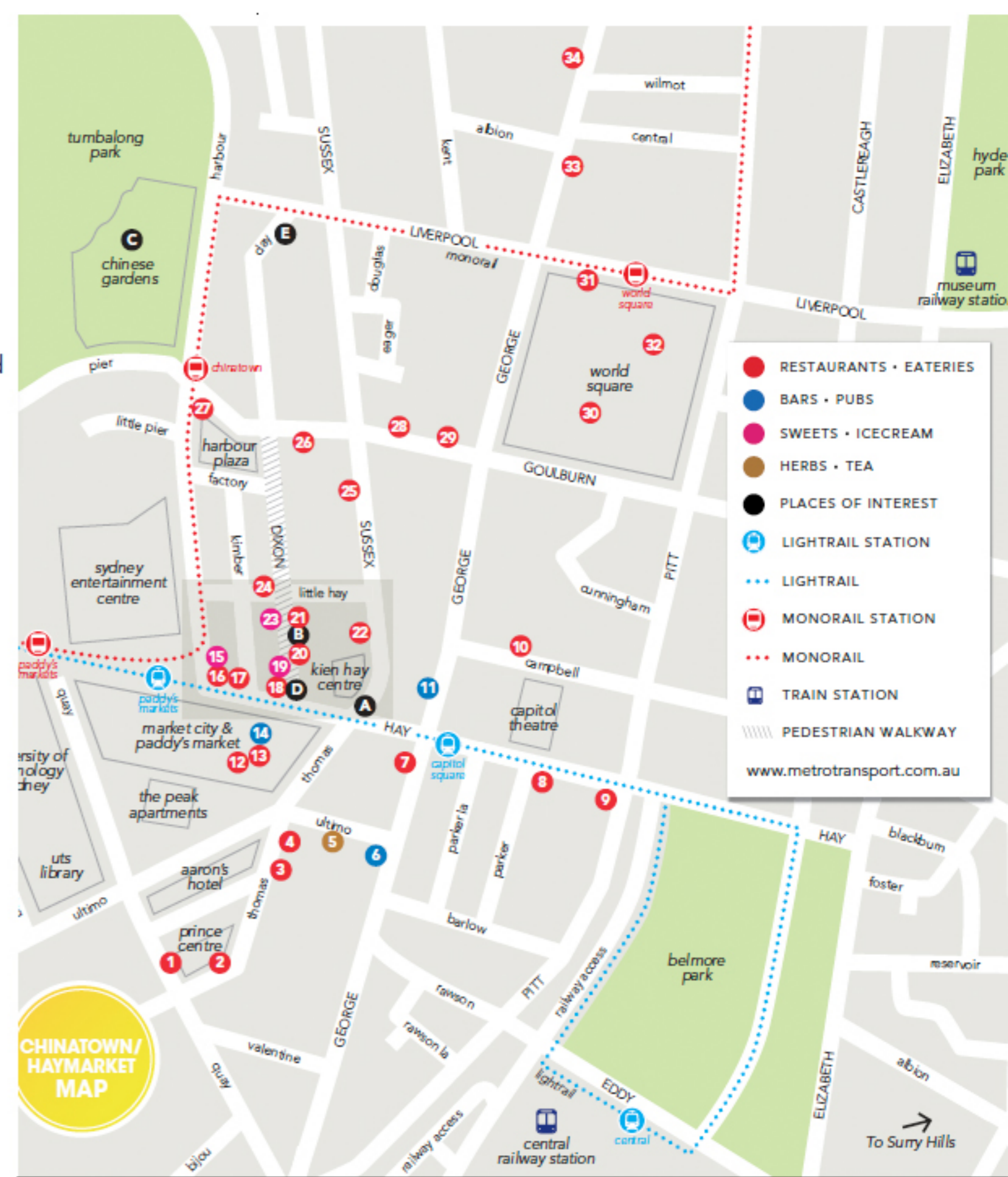

Starting from \$3.40, fares are available onboard. Trams operate every 10-15mins (every 30mins after midnight) 24hrs a day, 365 days a year.

Monorail

Starting from \$4.90, fares are available at any station. Monorails operate every 3-5mins until 10pm, 364 days a year (closed Christmas Day).
