HOW TO GET THERE

BY TAXI:

10 minutes from CBD

380 bus (via Museum Station, then Oxford Street)

L82 bus (via Museum Station, then Oxford Street; limited stops)

389 bus (via Glenmore Road)

Central Station – Circular Quay

311 bus (via Museum Station, then Taylor Square and Darlington Road)

Central Station – Bondi Junction

378 bus (via Museum Station)

Marrickville – Bondi Junction

352 bus (via Newtown and Surry Hills, then Oxford Street)
